Cargill Meat Solutions is one of the largest agricultural product producers in the world. Their Friona location in the Texas Panhandle employs approximately 2,000 residents of the surrounding rural communities and produces more than 3 million pounds of beef per day. The facility operates 24 hours a day with two production shifts and a third for maintenance and sanitation.

Cargill is strongly committed to the health and safety of its employees and contractors and has developed stringent safety protocols, which are used consistently throughout the organization. Contractors are required to follow Cargill's safety

performance criteria, but Cargill was struggling to find a quality service provider that could meet its safety standards and project deadlines. Cargill facility team members had previous work experience with TD service team members, and after TD provided Cargill a presentation detailing its service capabilities and award-winning safety culture, Cargill engaged TD to provide an internal design for an air-flow study with proposed solutions for the Friona facility.

The previous air-flow system had been creating pockets of heat and humidity resulting in a high rate of employee discomfort and subsequent turnover. Cargill needed a solution to provide a better environment for its employees. TD used thermal imaging to create 3D scans of the affected areas to analyze the heat load. Major improvements included replacing the air conditioning/heat units for the cafeteria. It provides daily meal

service for 1,800 employees, but the two, 17.5-ton package air conditioning/heating units had reached the end of their useful life and were not functioning properly. TD replaced the units with new 10-ton and 5-ton units.

Throughout each assignment, TD has met all Cargill safety requirements, including completing job safety analyses (JSAs) prior to start of any work. As the relationship has grown, TD has introduced Cargill to its nationally recognized, ZERO Harm program, which includes the completion of TD pre-task safety plans. Cargill appreciates the pre-task plans because they require even more extensive safety protocols and planning that Cargill's JSA.

Based on TD's quality performance and dedication to safety, in 2020 Cargill expanded the preventive maintenance program to include two feed milling facilities. Through a shared commitment to safety, quality and performance, TDIndustries is supporting Cargill Meat Solutions goals of employee well-being and productivity.
